Challenge matches for the title at several tournaments were quite common at that time among the professionals and also among the amateurs. So it was also at the FSFAB 1908 that a match for the world championship title took place.

Why Charles Darantière was allowed to issue this challenge based on the April 1908 championship in Paris as fourth-place finisher cannot be determined with certainty. Probably Lucien Rérolle and Henri Blanc did not exercise their right to do so.
