### **1910 Paris (FR) 08.-10.05.1910** - Challenge match for the title

1200 Points without equal innings. Challenge match in three sections of 400 points.

Tournament average: 9,92 (2383 / 240)

Challenge matches for the title at several tournaments were quite common at that time. So it was also at the FFB 1910 that a match for the world championship title took place.

Georges Martin, the runner-up in the last World Championship, did not exercise his right to challenge.

In 1912, the FFB did the same.
