





## World record for the highest series and best game by Francis Connesson

In this series of 199 points, the balls lay in two tiny depressions. By playing a very sensitive rail shot, the Frenchman managed to ensure that balls two and three did not leave the indentations in the cloth and



remained in the ideal position. An incredible achievement by Connesson, who pinched his eyes shut for several

minutes after the match, tired from the effort, and repeatedly shook his right wrist. However, this exertion did not leave him unscathed, and in the following game against Raymond Ceulemans he was exhausted and lost without a chance.
