The evident superiority of Alfred Mortier was expressed less in the in the average than in the clarity of the games won. He scored 2800 points, while his opponents only scored a total of 1510 points against him.

The trophy

Parallel to the Alfred Mortier vs. Charles Darantière match, in the same hall but one floor higher, the American professional Willie Hoppe played in an exhibition a world record series of 622 points in balkline 45/2. Of course, almost all the spectators wandered there to applaud loudly during all the difficult strokes. Moreover, from the 350th point onwards, the referee counted very loudly every point up to 622. Thus, Alfred Mortier and Charles Darantière were at the end of their concentration.
