The organizers from the USA insisted that this world championship was played according to the 'safety play', where the player is allowed to move an awkwardly placed ball with the cue to a more favorable spot. After protests from European players and officials demanding compliance with UIFAB rules, the tournament organizers gave in, but with the restriction that 'safety play' would still be allowed for USA players. However, the American players showed great sportsmanship and waived this perk.

The tournament was played on wine-red cloth with a yellow ball instead of a red one. The material was also unusual, for example, the plate was only 1,5 cm thick and consisted of two layers of steel and two layers of wood with a "springy" effect. There was no chance to change this.

Although unusual, the requirement to play in a smoking jacket in the evening certainly had no further effect on the results.

In January 1936 a qualifying tournament for the World Championship was played in France, in which the American Elmar Sidney Prather, who was living in Europe at that time, also took part. Originally, this tournament was even planned as a world championship in Amsterdam, but was then moved to Marseille as an elimination tournament. However, it was to remain a qualifier of no significance, because in the end players went to the USA who did not take part in Marseille or who finished second, fourth and fifth.

A subsequent declaration as the European Championship was not officially confirmed.
