Augusto Vergez's dominance was particularly evident in the fact that he not only won all his games, but always had a clear lead of more than 10 points (except in the game against E. Miro). In addition, he set new world championship records in average and best game.



## South American enthusiasm

"The opening of the World Cup took place in a packed theater. From the first floor to the highest seats, not a single seat was empty. Entire rows of cars on Victoria Street and a crowd at the entrance. Signs 2 meters high with the names of the players and their titles in giant letters were placed at the entrance. The performance of the participants was lively celebrated by cheers. Lagache enjoyed a stormy welcome, but when the two Vergez appeared, there was a mad outburst of joy. It took a long time for the shouts of 'Matungo' and 'Tito' to die down. The milieu was exactly that of a cycling, soccer or boxing event.

During the fights, all the lights were turned off and only the two strong electric lamps, placed about 5 meters above the billiards, were on, so that only the billiards, the players and the referees were in the light. This was something new again.

When the Argentinean won, an indescribable storm of applause broke out. The spectators of the first ranks seized the winner and carried him along in triumph."

(A contemporary report by Alexandre Avé from the UIFAB board.) The number of visitors was estimated at 15.000.

The "side program" was also impressive. Every day in the morning and in the evening the Spanish professional Isidro Ribas showed art and fantasy shots. Ribas was the world's best billiard artistique player of his time.
