The play-off ended in a draw and was extended by one fifth of the distance (10 points).

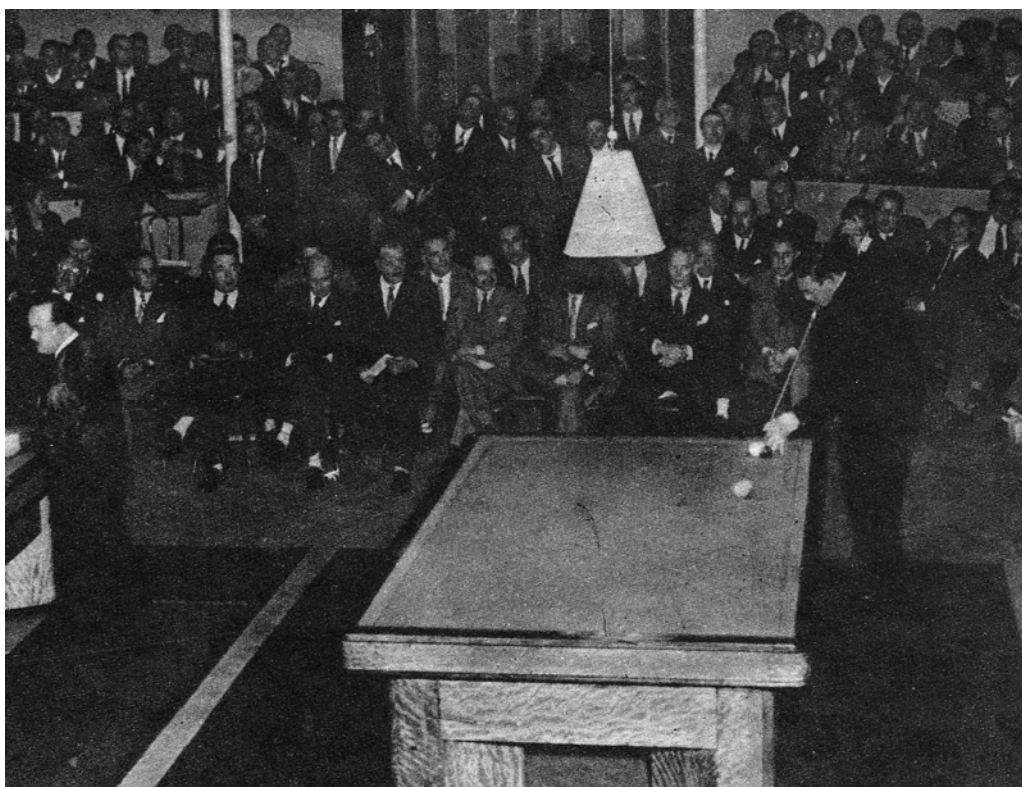
