Originally, the world championship was to be held in Tokyo, but the Japanese cancelled at short notice. The Egyptians stepped into the breach and were an exemplary organizer. There was only one problem: the cushions! Some local craftsman probably didn't take it very carefully when installing them. Height differences of up to 4 mm (!!!) ruined every controlled game, instinct had to replace calculation.

The first effects of the conflict between the UMB and the BWA became apparent at this championship. The top players contractually bound to the BWA (including Raymond Ceulemans, Marco Zanetti, Ludo Dielis, Nobuaki Kobayashi) stayed away from the tournament.
