### Details

Although there were previously only two national federations, players from other nations could still take part if they were members of one of these two billiards federations. Josef Klinger was Austrian and Albert Poensgen was German.

Paul Lejeune (FR) played under the pseudonym "Janssaud".

Alfred Mortier was originally supposed to play for France, but he had to cancel due to illness.

There has been an extraordinary change this year in how match points are awarded, which are made up of game wins, individual player averages and maximum series per game.

Winning a game = 10 game points

Average from 6 to 7.99 = 1 game point

from 8 to 9.99 = 1.5 game points

from 10 to 14.99 = 3 game points.

Series between 30 and 44 = 0.5 game points

between 45 and 59 = 1 game point

between 60 and 74 = 1.5 game points

between 75 and 89 = 2 game points

between 90 and 104 = 2.5 game points.

This scoring system only existed in 1909, in 1910 the usual scoring system was used again.
