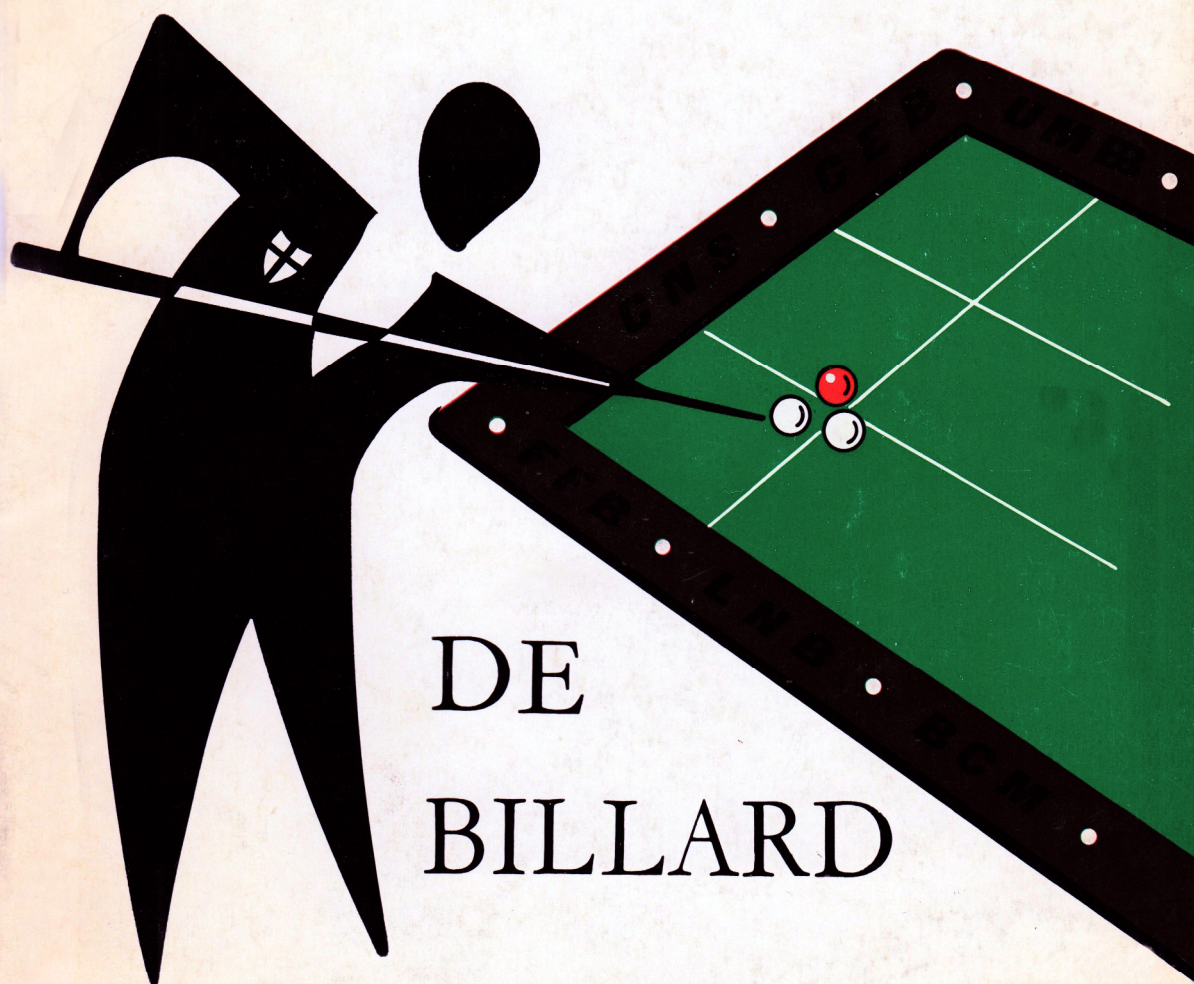

The rapidity of Jean Marty

Jean Marty set a new record in general averadge and was also known as the fastest cadre player in billiards history. Living in Paris as a professional, he had to come up with something special to stand out from the shadow of Roger Conti: building up the serie at the line at the anchor, then passing through by reverse shot just past the cadre cross and back again. The real secret to his speed, however, lay on the floor. His game was structured so that he had to cover only short distances with his legs. Only in this way was it possible to play games between 30 and 45 minutes per match.

The only ones to be pitied were the referees, who hopelessly got tangled up in all the entrés, dedans, à cheval, and the whole partout.



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
